Irish Water have notified Clare County Council in respect of potential outages on the West Clare Regional Water Supply and all Group Water Schemes supplied by this supply as a result of upgrade works on the new Doolough Treatment Plant. Customers may experience intermittent reductions in pressure of supply for the period between Friday September 17th and Thursday September 30th. Tankers of water have been set up at Knockerra Church to provide an alternative water supply to customers in the event of water outage.
