Irish Water have notified Clare County Council in respect of potential outages on the West Clare Regional Water Supply and all Group Water Schemes supplied by this supply as a result of upgrade works on the new Doolough Treatment Plant. Customers may experience intermittent reductions in pressure of supply for the period between Friday September 17<sup>th</sup> and Thursday September 30<sup>th</sup>. Tankers of water have been set up at Knockerra Church to provide an alternative water supply to customers in the event of water outage.
