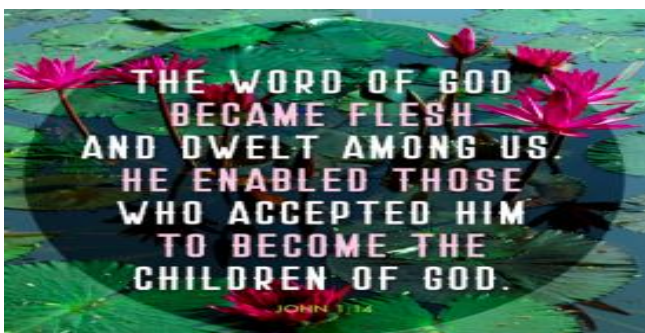
Chair Yoga classes with Trish Cleary will be taking place through zoom on the following dates:
