**Synod 2021 -2023**

Pope Francis has called a Synod of the whole Church. Everyone is called to be involved. The Synod began last October and will culminate in Rome in 2023. Every parish and diocese is asked to give input. What is a Synod? The word “synod” evokes the image of “walking together on the way”. For the Church it is a time-honoured way of working out together the “navigation map” for the Church at particular times. Synodality is about the whole People of God helping each other listen to what the Holy Spirit is saying to the Church. Pope Francis emphasises that this is not simply a matter of discussion as in a parliamentary debate. Rather it is primarily a time of listening and discernment. Pope Francis has emphasised that “it is precisely this path of synodality which God expects of the Church of the third millennium”. We need to listen to each other in an honest manner and see what the Holy Spirit is saying to all at this time. For this year (2022) our focus is on the Global Synod which is on the theme of Synodality. Pope Francis asks us as Christian Communities to reflect on how we are becoming a Church which is Synodal, how we are becoming a listening Church which walks together.
