Every Lent Trocaire shares with us all, the story of one family and they invite us to see the

world through their eyes. This year we meet Thandekile. Thandekile is a thirty-one-year-old Zimbabwean mother of two children. Her daughter's name is Nomatter and she is aged eleven, and her son's name is Forward and he is aged eight. In November 2020, the family's already fragile world was turned upside down when Covid-19 hit. Thandekile's husband, Donovan (35), died from Covid-19 while working in South Africa to earn an income to provide for his family. Left widowed, now Thandekile's greatest fear is that she will die from Covid-19 and there will be no one to look after her children.

We are invited to consider the reality of life for many through the prism of this family's story this Lent. Where is God for this family? Where is God calling us to be for them?
