Reek Sunday

Reek Sunday in Ireland, also known as Garland Sunday, is a religious event where pilgrims climb the sacred mountain. The climb takes over three hours and is a famous pilgrimage spot as it is believed St. Patrick summited the mountain and stayed there for 40 days. During this period, he fasted and prayed to the higher power. It is believed that at the end of the fast, St. Patrick threw a bell down the mountainside and banished the snakes from Ireland. It is due to this gift from St. Patrick that Ireland became habitable.
