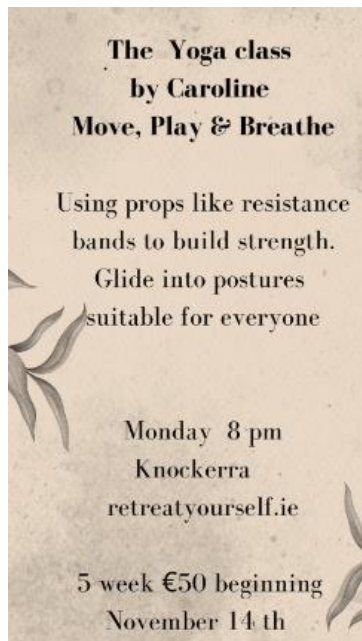
Rosary
