Presentation Of The Lord Candlemas:

Candles for use in the home & church should be left on the front seats of the church & will be blessed at 8.55 am Mass in Killimer on Friday & also during 10.30am on Sunday 4th February. Faith in the Church has traditionally been regarded as a light. At baptism a lighted candle represents the faith story the newly baptised child has become part of. We use them in our liturgies down through the ages.
