Free 'Communicating with Doctors' Workshop

Family Carers Ireland is hosting a Communicating with Doctors Workshop on March 25th at Kilrush Health Centre, aimed at helping family carers communicate more effectively with GPs and healthcare providers. Many family carers face significant challenges in securing GP appointments and effectively communicating their needs, often feeling overlooked in the healthcare system. This practical workshop equips them with essential tools and strategies to navigate these conversations with confidence, ensuring they receive the recognition, support, and care they deserve.

Developed by experts at Maynooth University, the workshop is based on research showing that carers often put their own health last. It helps them prepare for GP visits, speak up about their own wellbeing, and build better relationships with healthcare professionals.
