All at Killimer GAA were saddened to hear of the passing of Tommy O'Driscoll. He had a lifelong passion for our club and whenever and wherever you met him it was always a good time to talk about football.

Tommy played Junior from 1968 to 1992 and shared the League successes of '68 and '69. In 2022, at the Covid delayed 50th anniversary celebration of these victories, his joy at remembering those great days shared with his club mates was evident. Tommy was a goalkeeper of great renown and got recognition from the county selectors in the '75 -'76 League campaign. Many will remember Tommy as a coach. The energy he showed as a player continued into this role and he was the manager of the 1992 team that won the O'Keefe Cup. He later went on to be President of the club and continued to support club activities right up to welcoming Liam McCarthy to the parish last year. We are very grateful to Tommy for all he did for our club over many decades. He understood what it takes to keep a club going and would regularly collect players to ensure that a team was fielded.
