Irish Bishops Pastoral Letter

Irish Bishops Pastoral Letter "Why Sunday Matters" As we journey through this Jubilee Year of Hope the Irish Bishops are inviting us to reflect on the immense significance of Sunday Mass for us as a believing community. They propose that the Sunday Mass should be an expression of our communion with God and with one another. It should be an opportunity to actively participate in the liturgy and in the core tenants of our faith. Finally, Sunday Mass should be an occasion where we hear and accept the invitation to be people of mission as we are sent out with the word "Go in peace to love and serve the Lord". The purpose of this message is to encourage us to reflect on what is special about Sunday and what it means to us as believers. It raises the questions as to how can we enrich our experience of Mass making it a central part of our lives?
